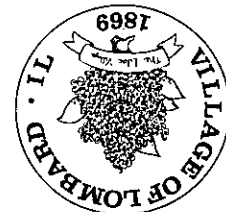

Special Assessment 217A includes: **Marcus Drive** from Grace Street to Joyce Avenue, **Lalonde Avenue** from Sunset Avenue to Marcus Drive and **Joyce Avenue** from Sunset Avenue to LeMoynes Avenue.

The project is the conversion of the existing rural cross section to an urban cross section. The work includes removing the existing roadway and ditches and constructing a fully improved street. This includes storm sewer, full depth asphalt pavement (9 inches thick), curb and gutter, ornamental street lighting and sidewalks. The work also includes the abandoning and filling of the rear yard sanitary sewers from Phase 2 of the Northeast Lombard Area improvements.

Thirty-five potential bidders and suppliers purchased forty sets of bid documents. Public Works Engineering received and opened twelve bids at 11:00 A.M. on February 11, 2008. The results are summarized below:
