Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading.

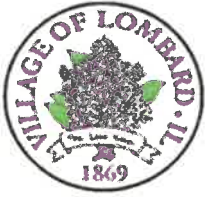

SUBJECT: Liquor License – August Hill Winery

In May, 2013, River Valley Vineyard, Inc. d/b/a August Hill Winery was issued a Class “Q-I” liquor license. The Class “Q-I” liquor license permitted them to participate in the Yorktown’s Farmer’s Market where they were allowed to have wine tastings and sell packaged wine during the event which was held June through September.

In reviewing Village Code, staff noticed that the number of entries in the Class “Q-I” liquor license category was never decreased after August Hill’s liquor license expired and they voluntarily never renewed their license. Consequently, as a housekeeping issue, staff has attached an ordinance decreasing the number of entries in the Class “Q-I” liquor license category by one as required by Village Code.

ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class “Q-I” liquor license category contained therein, to read as follows:

Class “Q-I” - 0

Section 2: That the decrease in the number of Class “Q-I” liquor licenses set forth in Section 1 above, is a result of River Valley Vineyards, Inc. d/b/a August Hill Winery voluntarily not renewing liquor license.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
