BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS:


Chapter 121 of the Illinois Revised Statutes requires any person, including a Municipality, obtain a permit from the Illinois Department of Transportation for working within the State rights-of-way. This includes emergency repairs to broken watermain.

The State also requires a surety bond with each permit application. The bond is required to ensure that work is completed in accordance with State specifications and the right-of-way is properly restored. However, the State does allow Municipalities to adopt a Resolution in lieu of the surety bond. The Resolution is valid for a period of 2 years from January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2024.
