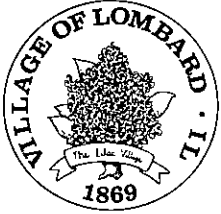

The FY 2008 budget includes replacement of SM481, a 2000 Bobcat 763 skid-steer loader. The bid results are as follows:

Vendor	Bid Price	Less Trade-In	Net Total Bid
Atlas Bobcat Schiller Park, IL	\$50,402	\$12,400	\$38,002

Public Works received one sealed bid from Atlas Bobcat. The bid price for the new skid-steer loader is \$50,402 less a trade-in allowance of \$12,400 equals a net total bid of \$38,002. The budgeted amount for this vehicle is \$38,000.

I recommend the award of a contract to the only bidder, Atlas Bobcat of Schiller Park Illinois, in the amount of \$38,002. I also recommend declaring Village unit number SM481, a 2000 Bobcat skid-steer with trailer and attachments, as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing its trade-in. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the April 19, 2007 meeting.

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND/OR DISPOSAL
OF MUNICIPAL OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard, it is no longer necessary or useful to or in the best interest for the Village of Lombard to retain the following described personal property:

Unit #SM481 a 2000 Bobcat skid-steer loader with trailer, three buckets, pavement breaker, and sweeper attachment. VIN #512254871

now owned by the Village of Lombard; and

WHEREAS, The Village routinely declares such type of personal property surplus and the best interest of the Village of Lombard will be served by its sale and/or disposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the President and Board of Trustees find the following described property:

now owned by the Village of Lombard is no longer necessary or useful to the Village of Lombard and the best interest of Lombard will be served by its sale/trade-in to Atlas Bobcat of Schiller Park, Illinois in the amount of \$12,400.00.

Section 2: Pursuant to said 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village President and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sell and/or dispose of the aforementioned personal property now owned by the Village of Lombard.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval as provided by law.
