The FY 2008 budget includes replacement of SM481, a 2000 Bobcat 763 skid-steer loader. The bid results are as follows:

Vendor	Bid Price	Less Trade-In	Net Total Bid
Atlas Bobcat Schiller Park, IL	\$50,402	\$12,400	\$38,002

Public Works received one sealed bid from Atlas Bobcat. The bid price for the new skidsteer loader is \$50,402 less a trade-in allowance of \$12,400 equals a net total bid of \$38,002. The budgeted amount for this vehicle is \$38,000.

I recommend the award of a contract to the only bidder, Atlas Bobcat of Schiller Park Illinois, in the amount of \$38,002. I also recommend declaring Village unit number SM481, a 2000 Bobcat skid-steer with trailer and attachments, as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing its trade-in.
