A waiver of first reading is being requested in order to bring the number of licenses available in the Class “A/B-II” classification current to reflect this change.

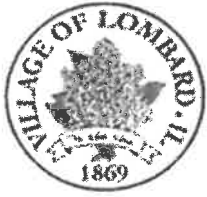

SUBJECT: **Text Amendment to Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A)
Number of Authorized Liquor Licenses – Class “A/B-II”
Anthony’s Coal Fired Pizza – 783 E. Butterfield Road**

Anthony's Coal Fired Pizza of Lombard LLC d/b/a Anthony's Coal Fired Pizza (ACFP) located at 783 E. Butterfield Road currently holds a Class “A/B-II” liquor license which allows them to serve alcoholic beverages as an adjunct to food service with no packaged sales. Staff received written confirmation from the corporate office indicating that the business has ceased operations. ACFP has also surrendered their liquor license which was received by staff on August 22, 2019.

Attached is an ordinance decreasing the Class “A/B-II” liquor license category by one as required by Village Code.

Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading in order to bring the number of licenses available in the Class “A/B-II” liquor classification current to reflect this change.

ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "A/B-II" liquor license category contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "A/B-II" - 5

Section 2: That the decrease in the number of Class "A/B-II" liquor licenses set forth in Section 1 above, is a result of Anthony's Coal Fired Pizza of Lombard LLC d/b/a Anthony's Coal Fired Pizza located at 783 E. Butterfield Road voluntarily cancelling their liquor license as they are no longer conducting business.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
