Due to a change in the 2010 annual gross dollars of alcoholic liquor, the following Class A/B liquor license holders require a change in their classification: Holy Mackerel, 70 Yorktown; TGI Fridays, 601 E. Butterfield Rd., and Greek Islands Restaurant, 300 E. 22nd Street.

SUBJECT: **Liquor License Classification Changes**

Please be advised liquor license holders with a Class A/B license are required to report their annual gross dollars of alcoholic liquor sales yearly. Three (3) of our liquor license holders require a change in their classifications as follows:

H.C. Management Lombard LLC d/b/a Holy Mackerel, located at 70 Yorktown, reported a decrease in their 2010 sales which changes their classification from a Class A/B III to a Class A/B II; and

TGI Friday's Inc. d/b/a TGI Fridays, located at 601 E. Butterfield Road, reported a decrease in their 2010 sales which changes their classification from a Class A/B III to a Class A/B II; and

Greek Islander Restaurant Inc. d/b/a Greek Islands Restaurant, located at 300 E. 22nd Street, reported an increase in their 2010 sales which changes their classification from a Class A/B II to a Class A/B III.

ORDINANCE _____
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class A/B II liquor licenses, contained therein, to read as follows:

“Class A/B II – 10”

SECTION 2: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class A/B III liquor licenses, contained therein, to read as follows:

“Class A/B III – 14”

SECTION 3: That the changes in the number of Class A/B II and A/B III liquor licenses set forth in Sections 1 and 2 above are as a result of H.C. Management Lombard LLC d/b/a Holy Mackerel, located at 70 Yorktown, reporting a decrease in their gross dollars of liquor sales in calendar year 2010, resulting in a change from a Class A/B III liquor licensee to a Class A/B II liquor licensee; TGI Friday’s Inc. d/b/a TGI Fridays, located at 601 E. Butterfield Rd., reporting a decrease in their gross dollars of liquor sales in calendar year 2010, resulting in a change from a Class A/B III liquor licensee to a Class A/B II liquor licensee; and Greek Islander Restaurant Inc. d/b/a Greek Islands Restaurant, located at 300 E 22nd Street, reporting an increase in their gross dollars of liquor sales in calendar year 2010, resulting in a change from a Class A/B II liquor licensee to a Class A/B III liquor licensee.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
