BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

080734: Ordinance to Restrict Parking on One-Side of the Street at Various Locations

The Transportation and Safety Committee voted to endorse an Ordinance restricting parking on one-side of the street in the area bounded by Main Street to the West, Grace Street to the East, Washington Boulevard to the South and Parkside Avenue to the North. Such ordinance will permit safe passage of emergency vehicles on these streets which have a width that is substandard relative to the Village's standard specification.

080734: Restrict Parking on One-Side of the Street at Various Locations

On December 1, 2008, the Transportation and Safety Committee discussed enacting a one-side "no parking" restriction for the streets shown on the attached maps. The streets in question are bounded by Main Street to the West, Grace Street to the East, Washington Boulevard to the South, and Parkside Avenue to the North.

Perceived Problem:

The streets shown on the attached map are impassable for plow/salt trucks, fire trucks and ambulances when two cars are parked opposite one another due to the narrower than normal pavement width. These streets are 25' wide, whereas the current standard pavement width is 28' and greater. Thus, emergency services are currently jeopardized for those residents. In addition, Waste Management has advised that they also have problems on this route. This is the only region in the Village that has this problem with narrow streets.

Proposed Solution:

Staff proposed to establish "no parking" zones on those sides with fire hydrants, which are shown as red dots. The existing "1-hour only parking" restriction on certain streets in the subject area would remain unchanged.

Proposed Timeline:

Staff requests that the Board waive the first reading so that the ordinance may be enacted on December 18th. The ordinance would take effect on February 1st. Staff would post the signs and mail notices to the affected residents in January.

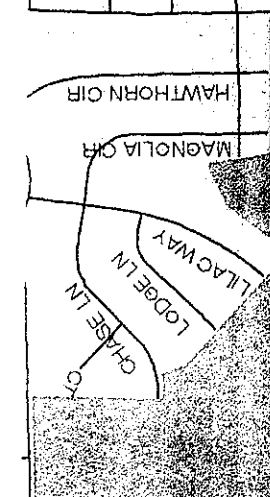
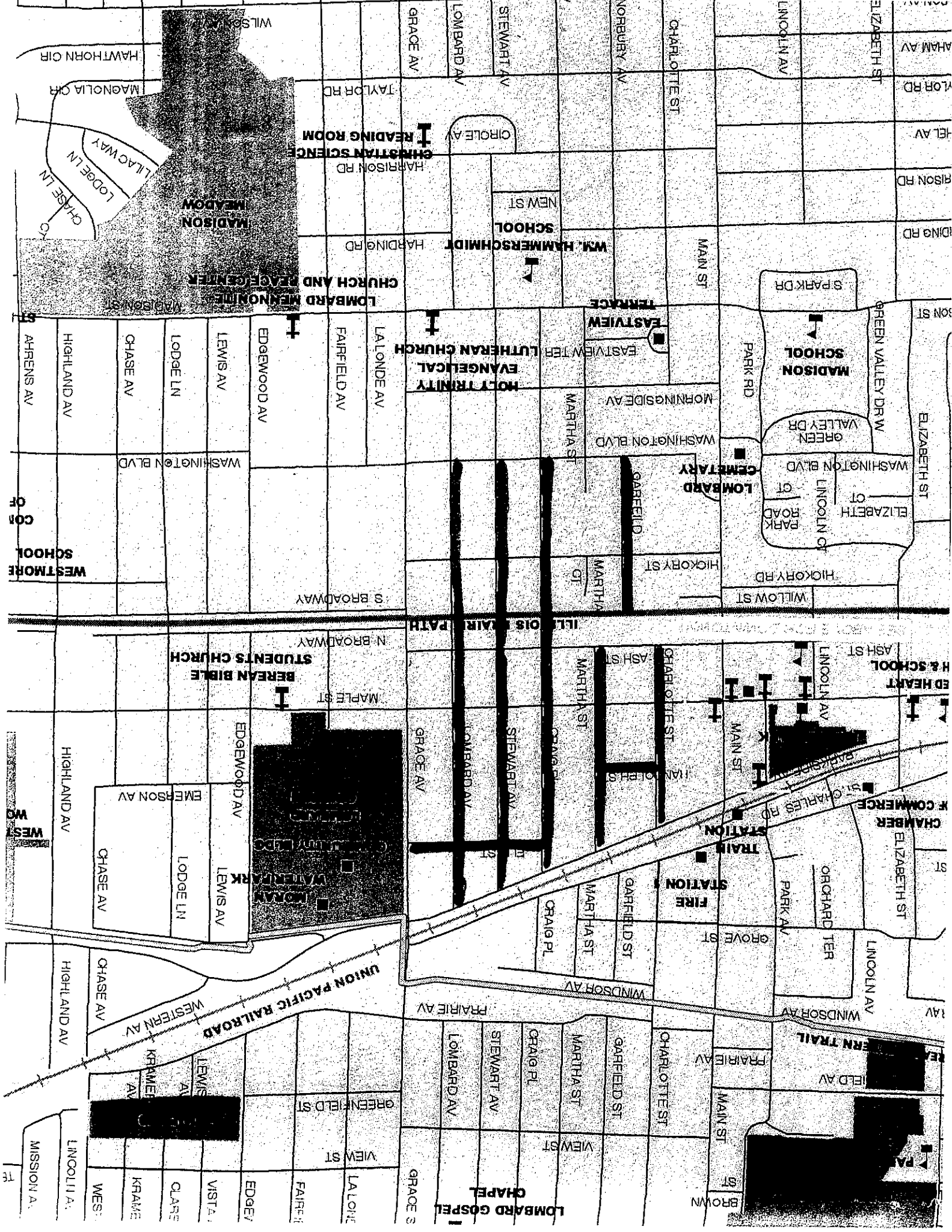

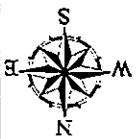

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule VII of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS be amended to add the following thereto:
