Seven (7) potential bidders purchased plans for the referenced project. Seven (7) bids were received and opened at 10:00 A.M. on April 5, 2007.

The lowest responsible bidder is Kings Point General Cement, Inc. of Bensenville, Illinois with a bid in the amount of \$749,890.00. Kings Point General Cement, Inc. successfully completed this project in FY2004. They currently have the contract for the FY2007 Driveway Apron and Sidewalk Restoration Program.

The bid documents identify that the awarded contract was to be made at the budgeted amount of \$990,000.00. Given that there is a difference between the bid amount and the budgeted amount of \$240,110.00, staff recommends awarding this contract to Kings Point General Cement, Inc. at the budget amount of \$990,000.00. PW Engineering would then be able to complete all of the estimated concrete rehabilitation and patches for FY2008. Additional work will be performed on a work order basis. Payments to the Contractor will be based on the actual work performed at the awarded contract unit prices.

Please present this item to the President and Board of Trustees for their review and approval at their regular meeting on April 19, 2007. If approved, please return two (2) executed copies of the contract to PW Engineering for further processing.

NOW, THEREFORE, if the said Principal shall well and truly perform said work in accordance with the terms of said contract and shall pay all sums of money due or to become due for any labor, materials, apparatus, fixtures or machinery furnished to him for the purpose of constructing such work and shall commence and complete the work within the time prescribed in said contract, and shall pay and discharge all damages, direct and indirect, that may be suffered or sustained on account of such work during the time of the performance thereof and until the said work shall have been accepted, and shall hold the Village of Lombard and its officers, agents and employees, harmless on account of any such damages, and shall in all respects fully and faithfully comply with all the provisions, conditions, and requirements of said contract, then upon the final payment by the Village to said Principal under said contract, the amount of this bond shall be reduced to ten percent (10%) of the amount set forth on the first page hereof for a period of one (1) year; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
