Tree Replacement Share Cost Options/Potential Reforestation Fund Sources

Staff recommendation to modify the ordinance to collect a fee calculated using replacement tree method described in memo.

Goldsmith: this item was tabled at the last meeting due to the fact that several committee members were absent. Presented a power point presentation to the committee. Discussion ensued regarding trees removed/replacements. Goldsmith: some people choose not to have a tree planted. That is where the \$150.00 charge comes in. Staff recommendation is to support the Tree Planting Program - to amend Village Code to establish 3 tiered program, and annually evaluate the planting cost through STC and amend Code to cover costs. Committee agrees with Number 1 for both Tree Planting Program and Tree Removal Fee Options. Committee requested an email of the Ordinance once it is drafted.
