**SUBJECT: Liquor License Amendment – TGI Friday’s
601 E. Butterfield Rd.**

TGI Friday’s #0063 d/b/a/ TGI Friday’s Inc. located at 601 E Butterfield Rd. currently holds an A/B-II liquor license. According to Village Code all “A/B” liquor classifications are based on the gross annual dollar amount of liquor sales. For the past 2 years, TGI Fridays has exceeded the maximum range of gross annual dollar liquor sales to remain in the A/B-II classification and must be reclassified into the A/B-III classification beginning with the June 1, 2014 liquor license renewal period.

Attached find an ordinance decreasing the Class A/B-II classification by one and increasing the Class A/B-III classification by one to reflect this change. Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading in order to be able to process the liquor license renewal in a timely fashion.

ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** as follows:

Section 1: That, effective June 1, 2014, Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "A/B-II" liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "A/B-II" - 8

Section 2: That, effective June 1, 2014, Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "AB-III" liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "A/B-III" - 15

Section 3: That this increase in the number of Class A/B-III liquor licenses and decrease in the number of A/B-II liquor licenses, as set forth in Sections 1 and 2 above, is as a result of TGI Friday's Inc d/b/a TGI Friday's restaurant located at 601 E. Butterfield Rd., Lombard, Illinois, reporting an increase in the gross dollars of liquor sales such that a change from Class "A/B-II" to Class "A/B-III" is required relative to the liquor license issued to TGI Friday's Inc.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
