The FY 2006 budget includes replacement of ST-375, a skid steer loader, SM-912, a skid steer trailer and the purchase of a new pavement planer. The bid results are as follows:

Vendor	Bid Price	Less Trade-In	Total Bid
Westside Tractor Naperville, IL	44,370	11,500	32,870
Patten Tractor Elmhurst, IL	57,518	7,800	49,718
Atlas Bobcat West Chicago, IL	45,784	9,500	36,284

Public Works received three sealed bids. The bid submitted by Westside Tractor did not meet village specifications because the loader lift height was too low and their machine would not run our existing attachments. Their machine also had manual controls where electric was specified. The total bid price for the *Skid Steer Loader with Trailer and Planer Attachment* is \$45,784 less a trade-in allowance of \$9,500 equals a total bid of \$36,284. The budgeted amount is \$50,000.

I recommend the award of a contract to Atlas Bobcat of West Chicago, IL. in an amount not to exceed \$36,284. I also recommend declaring village unit numbers ST-375 and SM912 as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing their trade-in. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the May 19, 2005 meeting.
