Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading in order to bring the number of licenses in each liquor license category current.

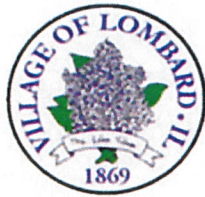

SUBJECT: **Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code
Alcoholic Beverages**

In accordance with Village Code, liquor licenses are renewed on a semi-annual basis. Village staff just completed the renewal process for the June 1 through November 30, 2017 licensing term. As a result, Tom & Eddies Better Burgers, Beer House and Thai Sushi Inn, voluntarily chose not to renew their liquor licenses and as of June 1, 2017 do not hold a valid liquor license. Attached is an ordinance decreasing their respective liquor license classifications (“C”, “L-II” and “U” respectively) by one to account for their non-renewal.

Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading in order bring the number of entries in each liquor classification current.

ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE TO REDUCE THE
NUMBER OF AVAILABLE LIQUOR LICENSES IN THE CLASS “C”, “L-II” AND
“U” LIQUOR LICENSE CATEGORIES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:**

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class “C” liquor licenses, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class “C” – 9

SECTION 2: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class “L-II” liquor licenses, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class “L-II” – 0

SECTION 3: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class “U” liquor licenses, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class “U” – 1

SECTION 4: That the changes in the number of Class “C”, “L-II” and “U” liquor licenses set forth in Sections 1, 2 and 3 above are as a result of T & E 348 Yorktown Center LLC d/b/a Tom & Eddies Better Burgers located at 348 Yorktown, Beer Haus LLC d/b/a Beer House located at 322 Yorktown and Golden 1 Inc. d/b/a Thai Sushi Inn located at 719 E. Roosevelt Road not renewing their liquor licenses for the June 1, 2017 liquor licensing term.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
