**SUBJECT: Request for a Decrease in the Number of Class A Coin-Operated Licenses
King's Hall – 1000 N. Rohlwing Road**

According to Village Code, Title 11, Chapter 110, Section 110.21(C) a Class A coin-operated license currently allows an establishment to have four (4) to eight (8) coin-operated amusement devices with no more than eleven (11) licenses allowed in the Village.

King's Hall currently has four coin-operated devices and possesses a Class A license. Recently the establishment eliminated all their coin-operated amusement devices in conjunction with the July 1, 2013 business licensing renewal period. Consequently, the removal of these coin-operated devices decreases the number of Class A licenses allowed within the Village.

Attached is an Ordinance decreasing the allowable licenses under the Class A coin-operated license category from eleven (11) to ten (10) to reflect their removal.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 110,
SECTION 110.21(C) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE
IN REGARD TO THE NUMBER OF
CLASS A COIN-OPERATED LICENSES**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 110, Section 110.21(C) of the Lombard Village Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

(C) In addition to the license required by Subsection (B) for each individual coin-operated amusement device, there shall be issued no more than the stated number of annual licenses in the following classifications for persons, firms, corporations or associations displaying for public patronage or keeping for operation any coin-operated amusement device:

Class A

Four (4) to eight (8) coin-operated amusement devices

No more than ~~eleven (11)~~ ten (10) licenses.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
