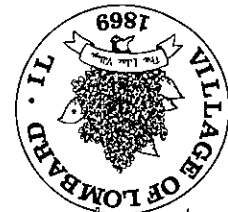

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entries relative to the Class A/B II liquor license category, contained therein to read as follows:

Class "A/B II" - 10

Section 2: That the change in the number of Class A/B II liquor licenses set forth in Section 1 above, is a result of granting a liquor license to Tocar Inc. doing business as Ristorante Loricca located at 203 Yorktown Center, Lombard.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
