Olde Towne - East, Phase 4 project area includes: **Grove Street** from Garfield Street to Martha Street and **Martha Street** from St. Charles Road to Windsor Avenue.

The project primarily involves the reconstruction of the existing roadway and the separation of the combined sewer system into individual sanitary and storm sewer systems. The scope of work includes removing and replacement of the existing asphalt roadway (including curb & gutter), street lighting, sidewalk, sanitary sewer service laterals, water main (including services from the main to the b-box) and the lining of the existing combined sewer main, which will become a sanitary sewer once the new storm sewer is constructed.

Fifty potential bidders and suppliers purchased fifty one sets of bid documents. Public Works Engineering received and opened seventeen (16) bids at 11:00 A.M. on February 10, 2009. The results are summarized below:

Public Works staff has worked with the John Neri Company on numerous projects for over the last fifteen years. Most recently John Neri was the sub-contractor on SA217A and the general contractor for the Main Street STP project.

Public Works-Engineering recommends award of this contract in the amount of \$1,167,260.53, to the John Neri Construction Company of Addison, Illinois
