Subject: No parking on south side of Morris Street from School St to Westmore/Meyers Rd. and placement of delineators at corners and mid-block.

A parking issue was brought forward by Ms. Beverly Shaver of 903 E. Morris Avenue and her daughter, Ms. Julie Shaver of 1146 S. Westmore/Meyers Road. Morris Avenue is heavily used to access Westmore/Meyers Road and Roosevelt Road. The roadway has a rural cross-section and the width of the pavement is twenty-eight (28) feet. Parking on both sides of the road poses a passing hazard, because of the roadside ditches.

Staff recommends a change to the Village Traffic Code to post, "No Parking" on the south side of Morris Avenue, between School Street and Westmore/Meyers Road. Delineators should be placed at the corners of Morris Avenue and mid-block to prevent motorist from driving in the ditch. The residents that brought this forward are the owners of the two properties affected by the "No Parking" restriction.
