**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING PUBLIC STREET PAVEMENT, STREETLIGHTS,
SIDEWALK, STORM SEWER, WATER MAIN AND HYDRANTS AT THE
GLEN (PIN #0620201009) IN LOMBARD, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the Private Engineering Services Division of the Village of Lombard has certified the completion of the public street pavement, streetlights, sidewalk, storm sewer, water main and hydrants at The Glen (PIN #0620201009) and has recommended that said improvements be accepted; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities concur with said recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the public improvements, as certified by the Private Engineering Services Division and as set forth on the approved engineering plans for the public street pavement, streetlights, sidewalk, storm sewer, water main and on-site eight-inch water main and hydrants at The Glen (PIN #0620201009), be and hereby are accepted for ownership by the Village of Lombard.

SECTION 2: That the on-site sanitary sewer will be the responsibility of the Highland Hills Sanitation District; that the four-inch water main, storm sewer and detention basins are to remain the responsibility of the property owner.


