- Experience in showing art for new/student artists
- Opportunity for middle and high school art students to become involved in a community art project, and be exposed to new artforms

This sculpture show would be open to artists residing or employed in DuPage County.

Proof of either is required. Special spots will be available for students. A call out for

significant talent of high school students will also be featured.

The fee is as followed:

Adult/Professional Artists: \$75

Art Coalition Members -\$35 (new members get in cheaper than full price)

College /Vocational or High school/ Disabled- No Charge with proof of ID

Money goes to support the public art program's matching grant and scholarship program

We can also fundraise that day from the public

Art coalition gets new membership funds/ splits the 20% of art sales monies

Each entrant needs to submit samples of work with dimensions. Two Artists may share a

section, however, each artist must be juried in.

Each Entry will be offered a 10x 10 ft section

Sculptures must be at least 2ft tall or long.

Provide your own tables or pedestals.

All art must be for sale or ordered for sale

We will have lightweight tables and chairs. The tables do not support heavy pieces and

are not for the artwork. Pieces larger than 15ft might be outside the tent.
