ORDINANCE _____AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.13 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "A/B III" liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows, effective July, 2006:

Class "A/B III" - 11
