

ORDINANCE NO. 6268

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule VII of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS be amended to add the following thereto:

| <u>Name of Street</u> | <u>From</u> | <u>To</u> |

| Lincoln Ave. West side | A point 235 feet north of the north curb line of St. Charles Rd. | A point 325 feet north of the north curb line of St. Charles Rd. |
| Lincoln Ave. East side | North curb line of St. Charles Rd. | A point 126 feet north |
| Garfield St. East side | Roosevelt Road | 13 th Street |

Section 2: That Schedule VII of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS be amended to delete the following therefrom:

| <u>Name of Street</u> | <u>From</u> | <u>To</u> |
|---------------------------|----------------|-------------------------|
| Garfield St. West Side | Roosevelt Road | 13 th Street |

Section 3: That Schedule VIII (t) of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN STREETS between the hours of 5:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m. during Cruise Nights be amended to delete the following therefrom:

| Grove Street North side | West curb line of Park Ave. | East curb line of Lincoln Ave. |

Section 4: That Schedule VIII (t) of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN STREETS between the hours of 5:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m. during Cruise Nights be amended to add the following thereto:

Section 6: That Schedule X (r) of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING TIME LIMITED ON CERTAIN STREETS for a period exceeding three hours between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. be amended to add the following thereto:
