SUBJECT: Liquor License – Lombard Grill, 1300 S. Main St.

The Village Board approved a liquor license for Lombard Grill, Inc. on October 15, 2009, pursuant to Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 of the Village Code, Lombard Grill, Inc. is required to use said liquor license within thirty (30) days of the granting thereof, or said liquor license would be terminated for the non-use thereof.

Due to construction delays, more than thirty (30) days have passed since October 15, 2009, and the restaurant has yet to open. Attached please find an Ordinance decreasing Class "A/B-I" liquor license by one (1), as required by Section 112.13 of the Village Code, for consideration at the February 18, 2010 Village Board meeting.

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class A/B-1 liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows:

“Class A/B-1 – 6”

This decrease in the number of Class A/B-1 liquor licenses, is as a result of Lombard Grill, Inc. d/b/a Lombard Grill, located at 1300 S. Main St., Lombard not proceeding to open its business and use the previously authorized Class A/B-1 liquor license within thirty (30) days of the granting of said liquor license, as provided for in Section 112.13 of the Lombard Village Code.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
