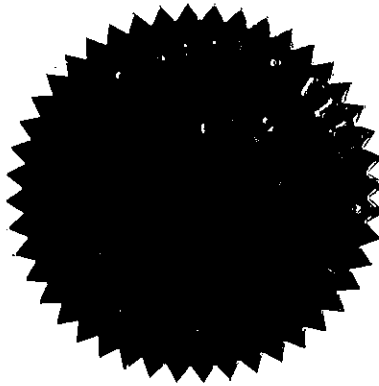

ORDINANCE 4976

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule XVIII of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled U-TURN PROHIBITIONS be amended to delete the following therefrom:

- Main Street southbound at Rebecca Road
- Main Street north and southbound at 13th Place
- Main Street north and southbound at 14th Street
- Main Street north and southbound at 14th Place
- Main Street north and southbound at the entrance to Westlake School
- Main Street southbound at 15th Street
- Main Street northbound at 16th Street/Four Seasons Park
- Main Street northbound at 20th Street

- Highland Avenue southbound at 13th Street
- Highland Avenue north and southbound at 13th Place
- Highland Avenue northbound at 14th Street
- Highland Avenue north and southbound at 14th Place
- Highland Avenue north and southbound at 15th Street
- Highland Avenue north and southbound at 15th Place
- Highland Avenue northbound at 17th Street
- Highland Avenue southbound at Highland Hills Recreation Center
- Highland Avenue north and southbound at Eastgate

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.






