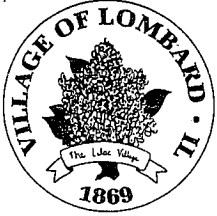

Subject: FY 2012B Snow and Material Hauling

The Village has a contract with D.A.S. Trucking Inc. for debris hauling. This contractor is unable to provide the sufficient amount of trucks to complete the snow hauling and paving operations. The Village has asked Marcott Enterprises, Inc. to provide snow and material trucking at the same rate as the contractor currently under contract. Marcott has been the contractor hauling material for the Village up until last year.

Public Works is requesting a waiver of bids and award of a contract to Marcott Enterprises Inc. not to exceed \$27,135.00 to haul snow and material on an as-needed basis as allowed by the Finance Department Purchasing Manual.

This Item will be competitively bid out in November 2012 for the 2013 fiscal year.
