WHEREAS, Deputy Chief Dane Cuny has worked with dedication and diligence and yet kindness, compassion and understanding; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Chief Dane Cuny has been known as the "Answer Man" based on his vast knowledge and experience; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Chief Cuny will retire effective November 12, 2010 from the Lombard Police Department after almost 34 years of service;
