The Private Engineering Services Division of the Community Development Department recommends that the Board of Trustees accept the public street, sidewalk, streetlights, sanitary sewer, storm sewer, watermain and fire hydrants at the Buckingham Orchard Subdivision. The stated improvements are acceptable as they were installed substantially to plan and have passed all required tests.
