**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE
(ORDINANCE NO. 1186) IN RELATION TO THE ADOPTION
OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE REGULATIONS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That the Lombard Traffic Code is hereby amended by revising Article III thereof to add a new Section 10-3-9 thereto which shall read in its entirety as follows:

"10-3-9. Traffic Control Devices.

The Village hereby adopts by reference the provisions of the most recent edition of the national manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, as published by the federal governmental, and the most recent edition of A Policy on Geometric Design of Highways and Streets, as published by the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials, for purposes of establishing traffic control devices within the Village. At least one (1) copy of each of the foregoing publications shall at all times be on file with the Village Clerk."

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
