



A resolution providing for the retirement of certain municipal indebtedness by the use of motor fuel tax funds

WHEREAS, the Village of Lombard has outstanding indebtedness described as follows:

\$4,600,000.00 General Limited Tax Debt Certificates, Series 2007, 07-00148-00-MB (Title of bond issue or paving district and municipal motor fuel tax section number)

WHEREAS, in the opinion of this body, the indebtedness described in the preceding paragraph may be retired with funds allotted to the municipality under the Motor Fuel Tax Law, and

WHEREAS, it appears that sufficient motor fuel tax funds are or will be available when the above indebtedness is due, and

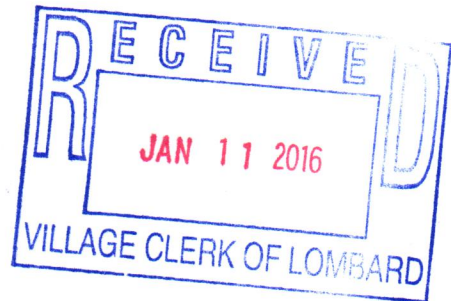

The Obligation Retirement Resolution adopted by the Village President and Board of Trustees on November 19, 2015, received on December 7, 2015, for the above-referenced section was approved as of December 21, 2015.

This appropriates \$775,875.00 of Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) Funds for the payment of principal and interest due on January 1, 2014, and principal and interest due on July 1, 2014.

The expenditure in the amount of \$170,017.42 for the retirement of the obligation from the Village's Unobligated MFT Account is authorized.
