FY 2005/2006 Police Squad And Administration Car Purchase

The FY 2005/2006 budget includes replacements for six marked squad cars. Policy is to purchase six new units and auction six old units per year. The budget also includes replacement of the Deputy Police Chief Administration car. Landmark Ford of Springfield, IL won State bid for the 2005 pursuit vehicle. The total for six squad cars at \$20,603 each is \$123,618. The Administration car is slightly less at \$20,403. The grand total for seven cars is \$144,021. Accumulated reserves of \$103,800 and auction proceeds are set aside for this purchase. To ensure Public Works will receive 2005 model year cars before September, staff must order them in March.

I recommend waiver of bids and award of a contract in the amount of \$144,021 to Landmark Ford of Springfield, IL for six 2005 Ford Crown Vic squad cars and one Police Administration car (also a 2005 Ford Crown Vic).
