**SCHEDULE VIII - PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN STREETS**

(m) In accordance with Section 10-13-3 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle in any of the following places between the hours of 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. on school days on the following designated streets:

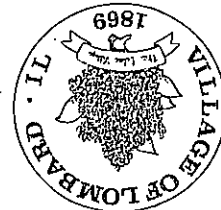

Subject: Request "No Parking, Standing, Stopping, School Days, 9AM-3PM"

On Friday, August 31, 2007, Public Works staff met with Lt. Dan Neustadt and Officer Joe Wagner to discuss a parking issue on Lincoln between Wilson and Graham. During afternoon pick-up, parents have been stopping on both sides of Lincoln to wait for their children. This situation impedes the flow of traffic on Lincoln in an already congested area. All parties agreed that on the west side of Lincoln between Wilson and Graham the "No Parking, School Days" should be changed to "No Parking, Standing, Stopping, School Days, 9AM-3PM". Signs were installed under the Authorization for Temporary or Emergency Placement of Traffic Control Regulation or Device.

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE**

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule VIII (m) of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN STREETS (9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. on school days) be amended to delete the following therefrom:

Section 2: That Schedule VIII (m) of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN STREETS (9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. on school days) be amended to add the following thereto:
