080685; Fairfield and 22nd Street Intersection; Traffic Signal

On November 3, 2008, the Transportation and Safety Committee discussed the results of a traffic study conducted on August 19 through August 21, 2008 at the intersection of 22nd and Fairfield Avenue. The study revealed a traffic signal was warranted at this intersection in accordance with four of the eight traffic conditions specified in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). The Committee voted to recommend installation of a Traffic Signal at this intersection for the Village Board's consideration.
