
Subject: Public Safety and Transportation and Committee Recommendation

Glenbard East High School Parking Restriction Modifications

The Public Safety and Transportation Committee requested Village staff to provide a comprehensive policy for parking around Glenbard East High School. Staff developed a more comprehensive approach to regulate the parking on the streets in the area of the school which is often used by students to park in the absence of on-site parking at Glenbard East High School.

As part of the policy preparation outreach, staff met with the principal of Glenbard East High School, notified the public via social media and website, and held public comment at the Public Safety and Transportation meeting. To address Committee comments, staff developed a policy for future requests to holistically restrict parking for all areas that generally lie within a 1/3 mile radius of the property limits of Glenbard East High School. The restriction of 2 hour parking between 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. on School Days will allow residents and visitors to utilize on-street parking, but will limit student parking based upon the inability for students to comply with the 2 hour limit. The final streets receiving this restriction was selected by the 1/3 mile radius as well as input from Trustee Ware and the Public Safety and Transportation Committee. These streets are located on the following page exhibit. Other areas not included within the exhibit would not be considered for additional restrictions, unless the Village Manager determines that a concern for public safety exists. These areas would be addressed on a case-by-case basis, with recommendations brought back through the Public Safety and Transportation Committee.

During the November 14, 2016 meeting, the Public Safety and Transportation Committee voted to recommend the policy and parking restriction in accordance with and addition to staff recommendation.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety and Transportation Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule VIII, paragraph M entitled "PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN STREETS" of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) is modified to the following restrictions:

"Ann Street from Main Street to Dead End" to "Ann Street from Main Street to Finley Road"

First reading waived by action of the Board of Trustees this ____ day of _____, 2016.

"Ethel Avenue from Main Street to Edson Street" to "Ethel Avenue from Main Street to Finley Road"

"Edson Street from Ethel Street to Edson Place" to "Edson Street from Madison Street to Morris Place"

"Hammerschmidt Ave from Central Ave to Taylor Road" to "Hammerschmidt Avenue from Dead End to Harrison Road"

"Harding Road from Main Street to Elizabeth Street" to "Harding Road from Hammerschmidt Avenue to Finley Road"

"Harrison Road from Main Street to Edson Street" to "Harrison Road from Hammerschmidt Avenue to Finley Road"

"Morris Avenue from Edson Street to Dead End" to "Morris Avenue from Finley Road to Dead End"

"Taylor Road from Hammerschmidt Ave to Charlotte Street" to "Taylor Road from Stewart Avenue to Charlotte Street"

Section 2: That Schedule VIII, paragraph M entitled "PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN STREETS" of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) is modified to add the following restrictions:

"Central Avenue from Main Street to Stewart Avenue"

"Charlotte Street from Harding Road to Madison Street"

"Lincoln Avenue from Roosevelt Road to Ann Street"

"Norbury Avenue from Madison Street to Central Street"

Section 3: That all new and existing streets within Schedule VIII, paragraph M entitled "PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN STREETS" of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) are moved to Schedule X, paragraph I entitled "PARKING TIME LIMITED ON CERTAIN STREETS" of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186).

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
