Park Avenue Permanent One-Way

During the Metra Station improvements project, Park Avenue was temporarily converted to a southbound one-way street from St. Charles Road to Michael McGuire Drive. The Village contracted KLOA, a traffic engineering consultant, to determine if Park Avenue should remain a one-way street permanently. Local businesses and the Lombard Town Centre support this permanent traffic pattern change. As part of the study, existing traffic and parking conditions were analyzed using previous and current conditions. The study supported retaining the one-way traffic flow.

During the January 4, 2016 meeting, the Public Safety and Transportation Committee voted to recommend making the one-way traffic pattern permanent in accordance with staff recommendation.

WHEREAS, the Public Safety and Transportation Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:
