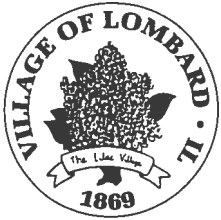

Subject: FY 2012B Road Salt Purchase

The State of Illinois has awarded the contract for rock salt for the FY 2012B. The successful bidder this year is Morton Salt Company. This year there is a **decrease** in cost of salt by **\$11.36**. The salt contract price will be \$52.74 per ton.

The Village Board approved joint purchase of rock salt with the State of Illinois on March 3, 2011. The Village requisition included an estimated 1,200 tons of salt. The Village is required to purchase 80% of this amount (960 tons) or at its option may purchase up to 120% of this amount at the same price (1,440 tons). The 1,200 tons of salt will be an addition to the 2,600 tons of salt the Village has under tarp on Eisenhower Lane.

Following through on the March 3, 2012 Board approval, authorization is requested to enter into contract with Morton Salt Company to purchase 1,200 tons of rock salt at \$52.74 per ton. The purchase order will be in an amount not to exceed \$63,288.00, which is a **decrease** of \$236,712.00 of the original budgeted amount of \$300,000. As a formality, I am requesting a waiver of bids.
