Attached please find Change Order No. 3 for this project representing an increase of seventy-four (74) days to the contract completion date and a decrease of \$5,799.43 to the contract amount. This change order represents construction time lost for the manufacturing of safety doors, upgrading property restoration materials, adjusting contract quantities for completed items, and liquidated damages for reimbursement of Resident Engineering costs.

Contract Time Adjustment and Liquidated Damages

On September 8, 2009, an inspection of the building revealed the need for panic hardware to be placed on two internal doors. After extensive research, it was determined the existing doors were unable to be modified and new doors were required. The ordering, manufacturing, transporting, and installation of the appropriate equipment required a total of seventy-four (74) calendar days, which is being requested as a contract time extension. If approved, the contract final completion date would be extended to November 15, 2009.

However, the project was not completed until December 31, 2009. The time taken to complete the project after the proposed November 15, 2009 contract deadline was caused by a failure of a pump motor during testing procedures. A new motor was provided and has since passed all testing requirements, but caused additional and unnecessary Resident Engineering costs that would not have been realized had the motor been properly manufactured or installed. Specific additional costs include investigating motor failure causes, observing motor re-installation and re-testing, and coordinating programming. It also includes all construction observations and reports for the project conducted after the contract final completion date that were not affiliated with the development of Record Drawings. These costs have been assessed at \$3,855.66 and are being requested as liquidated damages.

Contract Cost Adjustment

The following table provides a detailed description of the project modifications and their associated costs. These changes represent the addition of two new interior doors as previously described, upgrading the driveway from asphalt to concrete and the yard from seed to sod, and removal of remaining unused quantities. The contract adjustment also includes reimbursement of the aforementioned liquidated damages for Resident Engineering services.

RESOLUTION R 10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER INVOLVING AN EXTENSION IN THE TIME OF THE CONTRACT BY THIRTY (30) DAYS OR MORE AND AN INCREASE IN THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF THE CONTRACT OF \$10,000 OR MORE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Illinois Compiled Statutes, Chapter 720, Section 5/33E-9, units of local government are required to make specific findings prior to authorizing any change order relative to a contract which would increase or decrease the dollar amount of the contract by \$10,000 or more, or would extend or shorten the time in which the contract is to be completed by thirty days or more; and

WHEREAS, staff has presented and recommended the proposed Change Order No. 3 to the contract between the Village of Lombard and Genco Industries, Inc. regarding the South Booster Station Project, as attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made part hereof, to the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard; and

WHEREAS, said change order attached hereto as Exhibit "A" would extend the time amount of the contract by seventy-four (74) days; and

WHEREAS, said change order attached hereto as Exhibit "A" would decrease the dollar amount of the contract by \$5,799.43; and

WHEREAS, said Change Order No. 3 combined with previously approved Change Order No. 1 and 2, would result in a total contract time extension of five hundred four days (504) days; and

WHEREAS, said Change Order No. 3 combined with previously approved Change Order No. 1 and 2, would result in a total contract increase in the dollar amount of the original contract by \$18,360.32.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That after reviewing the explanation of staff as to the necessity of and reasons for the change order attached hereto as Exhibit "A", the President and Board of Trustees find as follows:

- A That the circumstances which necessitated said change order were not reasonably foreseeable at the time the contract was entered into.
- B. That the basis of the change order was not within the contemplation of the contract when the contract was signed.
