**SUBJECT: Amending Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A)
Class "V" Liquor License Category Description**

Village Code Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A) includes a Class "V" liquor license category description which provides for beer, wine and champagne only, served as an adjunct to the providing of a beauty salon service with no package sales allowed. All consumption of alcoholic beverages must be supplied by the licensee and food may be brought to the licensee premises. Currently, there is one liquor license issued in the Class "V" liquor license category.

The proposed change in the liquor description is in response to two inquiries (one from an existing fine men's salon and the other from a full-service salon/spa) who would like the ability to serve wine and/or champagne to guests who pay for a salon/spa service. As the current Class "V" description does not include "men's salons", nor does it include "spa services" (facials, body waxing, scrubs and massage), staff is recommending that the classification description be amended.

Staff met with Village Counsel who drafted the attached ordinance for Village Board consideration. The ordinance amends the Class "V" liquor license category to be applicable to both full service beauty salons (which may include spa services) and full service barber salons. This classification would not be applicable to other limited beauty, spa service or massage establishments.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.12(A)
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE
IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
AND THE CLASS "V" LIQUOR LICENSE CATEGORY

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the description of the Class "V" liquor license, as contained therein, as follows:

- A. In the first sentence, revise "beauty salon services" to read, "full service beauty salon services (which may include spa services) and/or full service barber salon services."
- B. In the second sentence, revised "beauty salon service" to read, "full service beauty salon service (which may include a spa service) and/or a full service barber salon service."

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
