Bid Waiver for Pavement Grindings Disposal FY 2005

For the past 3 years we have been recycling our pavement grindings generated by the Street Division during the in-house Grind and Overlay Program through our asphalt supplier. This year we have once again recycled through Crush-Crete a division of DuKane Asphalt. We are currently being charged \$50.00 per load whether it is a semi truck loads (23 tons) or a 6 wheel truck load 14 tons). This fiscal year our snow and debris hauling is charging us \$145.00 per load to haul and dispose of a load or asphalt whether it is busted up chunks from a water dig or the street grindings generated by our grinding program.

Now that the grinding portion of the program is completed, I have calculated how much money has been saved just in hauling costs of the grindings. We have hauled 213 loads of grindings to Crush Crete, Inc., for a total cost of \$10,650. If we had disposed of the grindings through our Snow and Debris Hauling contract the total cost would have been \$30,885. That is a savings of \$20,235 recycling as we grind rather then our trucks hauling to the Garfield property and at a later date reloading the grindings on our Snow and Debris Hauling contractors trucks for disposal.

I am requesting to have a waiver of bid and award a contract to Crush-Crete, Inc. in the amount of \$10,650 for the recycling of the street grindings. There is currently a purchase order in the amount of \$9,000 that we have been paying off of since the beginning of August. With the approval of this contract we will increase the current purchase order by an amount of \$1,650.00.
