SUBJECT: **Amending Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A)
Class "X" Liquor License Category Description**

Staff received a request from AMC Dine-In Theater, who currently holds a Class "X" liquor license, to have the ability to have a portable service bar in one of the theatres for a private special event in May. AMC further indicated that if the request was approved it would not be limited to a one-time event but could become part of their overall marketing plan. Currently the description of the Class "X" liquor license limits alcoholic beverages to a designated lobby bar area and does not allow for this request.

Staff met with Village Counsel who drafted the attached ordinance for Village Board consideration. The ordinance amends the Class "X" liquor license category description to allow a single portable service bar as long as the entire movie theater auditorium is rented for a private event (and is not open to the public) and that the preparation and service of the alcoholic beverages at the portable service bar can only be done by an employee of the licensee. This amendment would apply to any liquor licensee who holds a Class "X" liquor license.

In order to accommodate their May event, staff is requesting a waiver of first reading.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI., CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.12(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE
IN REGARD TO THE CLASS "X" LIQUOR LICENSE CATEGORY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title XI., Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising subsection (1), of the Class "X" liquor license category description contained therein, to read in its entirety as follows:

"(1) Preparation of alcoholic beverages shall be limited to a designated lobby bar area. Notwithstanding the foregoing, where an entire movie theater auditorium is rented for a private event, not open to the public, the preparation and service of alcoholic beverages, relative to said private event, may be done at a single portable service bar located with the movie theater auditorium, provided that the preparation and service of the alcoholic beverages at said portable service bar shall only be done by an employee of the licensee."

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
