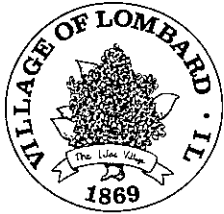

As a cost saving measure for the Village, over the past few years Engineering has combined dust control for all C.I.P. projects into a single contract, as opposed to having it provided in each individual project. This has allowed the Village to respond to and address specific project needs as well as overall dust control requirements in an efficient and cost-effective manner.

Due to the specialty nature of the work, for the FY 2005 season, proposals were requested from 3 companies for this project. 2 proposals were received and opened at 10:00 a.m. on May 25, 2004.

An evaluation of each proposal is summarized below:

	CAM, LLC	GASAWAY DISTRIBUTORS INC.
Load	3000 gal.	1300 gal.
Rate of Application	0.5 gal/yd ²	0.3 gal/yd ²
Coverage Area	6000 yd ²	4333 yd ²
Price / Load	\$1,700.00	\$1,304.00
Price / (1/2) Load	\$850.00	N/A
Price / Square Yard	\$0.28/yd ²	\$0.30/yd ²

After evaluating the two proposals, it was determined that Cam, LLC is proposing a lower cost per square yard than Gasaway Distributors, Inc. Cam, LLC also provided a unit price for half loads, which allows the Village greater flexibility. Gasaway Distributors, Inc. proposed using calcium chloride, which is known to have corrosive effects are detrimental to the environment. Therefore, the Engineering Division recommends the award of this contract in the amount of \$35,000.00 to Cam, LLC of South Roxana, IL.
