Design services were solicited via the Engineering Division Short-List Request for Proposal (RFP) process, using the Olde Towne East, Phases 3, 4 and 5 project as the Of the eleven design firms that submitted proposals, Civiltech target project. Engineering of Itasca received the highest overall rating from the five-person evaluation committee. The total contract amount is a not to exceed fee of \$284,691.

This project involves the design of utility and roadway improvements of project area listed below

- 4) Final engineering will not proceed until the preliminary report is approved. This will allow the Village to review the project cost for the entire area and program the approved scope of improvements.
- 5) Preparation of construction documents.
- 6) Preparation of IEPA and storm water permits as necessary for the scope of improvements.
