AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III., CHAPTER 32, ARTICLE VI., SECTIONS 32.075, 32.077, 32.078 AND 32.079 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO CHANGING THE NAME OF THE HISTORICAL COMMISSION TO THE LOMBARD HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title III., Chapter 32, Article VI. of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the title thereof to to read in its entirety as follows:

"ARTICLE VI. LOMBARD HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION"

SECTION 2: That Title III., Chapter 32, Sections 32.075(A), 32.077, 32.078, 32.079(A), 32.079(E)(1) and 32.079(F)(1) of the Lombard Village Code are amended by revising the references therein to "Historical Commission" to read "Lombard Historic Preservation Commission."

SECTION 3: That Title III., Chapter 32, Article VI., Section 32.079(G)(2) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the reference therein to "Historical Commission's" to read "Lombard Historic Preservation Commission's."

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, as provided by law.
