ORDINANCE NO. 7101

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY TERMINATING A CLASS "M" LIQUOR LICENSE AND CREATING A NEW CLASS "M" LIQUOR LICENSE, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the language related to Class "M" liquor licenses as follows:

"Class 'M' – 0"

This decrease in the number of Class "M" liquor licenses reflects the termination of the Class "M" liquor license issued to J. Richard Oltmann Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a Enchanted Castle, located at 1103 S. Main Street, Lombard, Illinois ("Licensed Premises"), due to prospective new ownership of the business operated on the Licensed Premises. The termination of said Class "M" liquor license shall become effective as of the date that the assets of J. Richard Oltmann Enterprises, Inc., related to the Licensed Premises, are transferred to the prospective new owner, FPS, LLC, or once said liquor license terminates as provided by the Village Code, whichever occurs first.

SECTION 2: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A) of the Lombard Village Code is subsequently further amended by revising the language related to Class "M" liquor licenses as follows:

"Class 'M' – 1"

This increase in the number of Class "M" liquor licenses reflects the prospective issuance of a new Class "M" liquor license to FPS, LLC, d/b/a Enchanted Castle, located at 1103 S. Main Street, Lombard, Illinois ("Licensed Premises"). This increase in the number of Class "M" liquor licenses for the Licensed Premises is expressly contingent on the transfer of the assets of J. Richard Oltmann Enterprises, Inc., related to the Licensed Premises, to FPS, LLC and FPS, LLC providing the Village with written documentation evidencing the transfer of such assets.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
