**SUBJECT:** **Special Event Liquor Licenses for Punky's Pub and Shannon's Deli for Chicago Bears Viewing Events – September & November, 2014**

Staff has received a request from Lombard Town Centre for two Chicago Bears viewing events to occur on Sunday evening September 14 and Sunday evening November 9, 2014.

To this end, attached please find the attached document relative to the above-captioned matter, for the September 4, 2014 Village Board Meeting:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.18(B) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, PROVIDING FOR THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL IN CONNECTION WITH A TEMPORARY EVENTS AT 11 AND 16 SOUTH PARK AVENUE

The attached ordinance also includes a number of special provisions to help ensure that the sale and consumption of alcohol is properly managed at such events. These limitations would be specifically attributable to these two events and would consist of the following:

- (a) The sale of alcoholic beverages shall occur within the buildings on the premises for which the Liquor Licensees each have a valid non-Class "J" liquor license (the "Licensed Premises") or outdoors, but within ten (10) feet of the main entrance of the Licensed Premises;
- (b) The sales and dispensing of alcoholic beverages in pitchers is prohibited;
- (c) No more than two (2) alcoholic beverages may be purchased by any person at the same time;

- (d) All individuals purchasing or consuming alcoholic beverages shall be required to wear a wristband, to indicate that they are at least twenty-one (21) years of age, and the Liquor Licensees shall be responsible for the verification of age and distribution of said wristbands; and
- (e) Alcoholic beverages, that are sold for consumption outside of the Licensed Premises, must be served in plastic cups with a capacity of no more than sixteen (16) ounces.”

The proposed amendments have been reviewed by staff and the two parties that would be subject to the regulation and they do not object to the additional provisions.

To accommodate the timing for the first event, a waiver of first reading is also requested.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.18(B)  
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES,  
PROVIDING FOR THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL IN CONNECTION  
WITH TEMPORARY EVENTS AT 11 AND 16 SOUTH PARK AVENUE,  
ON SEPTEMBER 14, 2014 AND NOVEMBER 9, 2014**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.18(B) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding a new subsection (6) thereto, effective upon the adoption of this Ordinance through 11:59 p.m. on Sunday, November 9, 2014, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

“(6) In light of the fact that Shannons on Park, Inc. d/b/a Shannon’s Deli, located at 11 South Park Avenue, and Bill and Punky’s Step Up Inn, Ltd. d/b/a Punky’s Pub, located at 16 South Park Avenue, (hereinafter collectively the “Liquor Licensees”), will be holding two (2) temporary events for the viewing of two (2) Chicago Bears regular season football games on September 14, 2014 and November 9, 2014, said Liquor Licensees shall each be eligible for a Class “J” liquor license, in addition to the Village liquor license currently issued to each of the Liquor Licensees, despite the fact that said Liquor Licensees are for-profit business entities, for the sole purpose of selling alcoholic beverages for consumption in a designated and secured area adjacent to each of said Liquor Licensees’ currently licensed premises, to be approved by the Village pursuant to the issuance of a temporary event permit under Chapter 110 of the Village Code, beginning two (2) hours prior to the start of each referenced Chicago Bears regular season football game, and terminating thirty (30) minutes after the conclusion of each referenced Chicago Bears regular season football game. The liquor licenses to be issued under this subsection (6) may be issued by the Local Liquor Commissioner upon proper application to the Village, and satisfaction of all applicable requirements and conditions by the Liquor Licensees. No liquor license shall be issued under this subsection (6) until such time as each of the Liquor Licensees obtains the necessary temporary event permit under Chapter 110 of the Village Code and complies with all requirements and conditions thereof, including, without limitation, the insurance, bond and indemnification requirements of Chapter 110 for temporary events. In

addition, if such liquor licenses are issued by the Local Liquor Commissioner under this subsection (6), said Liquor Licensees shall, notwithstanding any other provisions of this Chapter 112, be subject to the following additional requirements:

- (a) The sale of alcoholic beverages shall occur within the buildings on the premises for which the Liquor Licensees each have a valid non-Class "J" liquor license (the "Licensed Premises") or outdoors, but within ten (10) feet of the main entrance of the Licensed Premises;
- (b) The sales and dispensing of alcoholic beverages in pitchers is prohibited;
- (c) No more than two (2) alcoholic beverages may be purchased by any person at the same time;
- (d) All individuals purchasing or consuming alcoholic beverages shall be required to wear a wristband, to indicate that they are at least twenty-one (21) years of age, and the Liquor Licensees shall be responsible for the verification of age and distribution of said wristbands; and
- (e) Alcoholic beverages, that are sold for consumption outside of the Licensed Premises, must be served in plastic cups with a capacity of no more than sixteen (16) ounces."

**SECTION 2:** That, effective at 11:59 p.m. on Sunday, November 9, 2014, Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.18(B)(6) of the Lombard Village Code, as set forth in Section 1 above, is hereby repealed, without need for any further action by the President and Board of Trustees.

**SECTION 3:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
