SUBJECT: Intergovernmental Agreement with York Township regarding Madison Street

#### **Background**

Included in the 2017 Asphalt Patching and Paving program is the paving of the Village's section of Highridge Road east of Westmore-Meyers Road. Between the Village's section of roadway and the corporate limits with Villa Park is a section of unincorporated roadway, approximately 708 linear feet.

Staff has been working with the York Township Highway Commissioner on an IGA that details the obligations of the Village and the Township on the project, including the Townships contribution towards the improvement. The IGA provides the following:

- The Village shall serve as the lead agency for the project; including any bidding, award and construction of the improvement.
- The Village assumes responsibility for the maintenance of the project area during construction. Upon completion and acceptance of the improvements, the Township Commissioner shall assume responsibility for the unincorporated section of roadway.
- The Village shall pay the cost of the construction of the roadway and curb/gutter, including the unincorporated sections. The estimate of the work is \$83,782.50.
- The Commissioner shall pay actual project costs (estimated at \$402,049) for the portion of the improvement to Highridge Road.

The IGA has been reviewed by the Village Attorney and is consistent with past IGAs executed by the Village and York Township. I respectfully request that this item be placed on the Village Board's agenda for the April 6, 2017 meeting.

#### Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Village Board of Trustees approve an Intergovernmental Agreement between the Village of Lombard and the York Township Highway Commissioner regarding improvements to Highridge Road.

# AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD AND THE YORK TOWNSHIP HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER REGARDING IMPROVEMENTS TO HIGHRIDGE ROAD

This Intergovernmental Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") is entered into this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2017, by and between the York Township Highway Commissioner (hereinafter referred to as the "Commissioner") and the Village of Lombard (hereinafter referred to as the "Village"). The Commissioner and the Village are hereinafter sometimes referred to individually as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties."

#### RECITALS

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 and 5 ILCS 220/1 et seq. authorize units of local government to contract or otherwise associate among themselves to obtain or share services, to exercise, combine or transfer any power or function, in any manner not prohibited by law, to use their credit, revenues and other reserves to pay costs and to service debt related to intergovernmental activities; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner has jurisdiction over Highridge Road, for a distance of approximately 708 feet, from 1112 Highridge Road to 1208 Highridge Road (hereinafter referred to as the "Township Roadway"); and

WHEREAS, the Village has jurisdiction over Highridge Road, for a distance of approximately 915 feet, from Westmore-Meyers Road to 1112 Highridge Road (hereinafter referred to as the "Village Roadway" – the Township Roadway and the Village Roadway being hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Highridge Roadway"); and

WHEREAS, the Highridge Roadway is in disrepair, and the Village and the Commissioner desire to make improvements, including a two (2) inch grinding and overlaying of the Highridge Roadway, and installation of curb and driveway apron replacement along the Township Roadway, as shown on <a href="Exhibit A">Exhibit A</a> attached hereto and made part hereof (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Village has prepared engineering plans, specifications and estimates for the Project under the supervision of a registered engineer in the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Village and the Commissioner to enter into an agreement to undertake the Project; and

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WHEREAS, the Village agrees to pay all costs and expenses associated with the design and construction of the Project, subject to being reimbursed by the Commissioner for the costs and expenses associated with the Township Roadway portion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Parties to this Agreement desire to set forth their respective rights and duties concerning the costs and expenses for the construction of the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by the Parties hereto, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

- 1. That the Recitals set forth above are made part hereof, as if set forth in full in this Section 1.
- 2. The Village will act as the lead agency for the design, bidding, award of the contract and construction of the Project.
- 3. The Village, as lead agency, will prepare sufficient documentation to determine the extent of services, improvements, and labor and material quantities associated with the Township Roadway portion of the Project, and all amounts/quantities shown in <a href="Exhibit B">Exhibit B</a> attached hereto and made part hereof, relative to the Township Roadway portion of the Project, and the Village Roadway portion of the Project, will be adjusted accordingly based upon the actual final quantities.
- 4. The Village will take over maintenance duties relative to the Highridge Roadway during the construction phase of the Project; that is, the Village will be responsible for maintenance, signage, access to properties and emergency services access. Upon completion of the Project, and written acceptance of the Township Roadway portion of the Project by the Commissioner, the Village shall transfer maintenance duties for the Township Roadway portion of the Project back to the Commissioner.
- 5. The Village will require all contractors to name the Commissioner and his officers, agents and employees as additional insureds on insurance policies, with certificates of insurance to evidence same, plus indemnification from said contractors relative to claims against the Commissioner as a result of the construction of the Project. The Village will require the contractor to meet or exceed minimum levels of insurance, based on either the Village's or the Commissioner's requirements, whichever is more stringent.
- 6. The Village agrees to pay, or cause to be paid, the actual costs for the Village Roadway portion of the Project.

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- 7. The Commissioner agrees to pay the actual costs for the Township Roadway portion of the Project, up to a maximum of \$83,782.50.
- 8. Upon completion of the Project, the Village shall provide the Commissioner with the actual cost incurred for the construction of the Township Roadway portion of the Project, as set forth on <a href="Exhibit B">Exhibit B</a>, along with documentation to support said amount. The Commissioner shall, within sixty (60) days of receipt of the foregoing, pay to the Village the amount of the actual cost of the Township Roadway portion of the Project, not to exceed the amount set forth in Section 7 above.
- 9. The Village will provide sufficient assistance throughout the Project to successfully coordinate utility shut downs, relocations, detours, haul routes, newsletters and customer relations in the Project area, as needed, if any.
- The Village shall complete or cause the completion of the construction of the Project under this Agreement, on or before October 15, 2017, absent force majeure.
- 11. The Commissioner agrees to issue any and all necessary permits relative to the Village's construction of the Project.
- 12. Notice or other writings which either Party is required to, or may wish to, serve upon the other Party in connection with this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be delivered personally or sent by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, and addressed as follows:


