CONTRACT DOCUMENT NUMBER M-08-07-ES

This agreement is made this 20th day of September, 2007, between and shall be binding upon the Village of Lombard, an Illinois municipal Corporation hereinafter referred to as the "VILLAGE" and Christopher B. Burke Engineering, Ltd. hereinafter referred to as the "ENGINEER" and its successors.

Witnessed, that in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties delineated in the contract documents, the ENGINEER agrees to perform the services and the VILLAGE agrees to pay for the following services as set forth in the contract documents:

2. The VILLAGE agrees to pay, and the ENGINEER agrees to accept as full payment for the services, which are the subject matter of this contract in accordance with the General Provisions.
3. This Contract represents the entire agreement between the parties and may not be modified without the written approval of both parties.

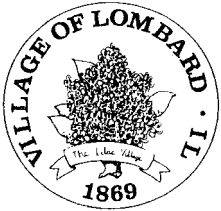

Subject: Garfield Site Design, Construction Layout and Resident Engineering Services

Attached please find a contract and resolution pertaining to the engineering services to develop the Public Works facility at the north end of Garfield Street. The selected firm will provide design, construction layout and resident engineering services for the project, not including the salt dome or the operation building.

Of the four short-listed firms that submitted proposals for this project, the Public Works evaluation team concurred that Christopher B. Burke Engineering, Ltd. (CBBEL) of Rosemont is the most qualified firm to serve as engineer for the project.

CBBEL has done design and construction engineering for many projects in Lombard, including the stormwater detention basin on this site. They are very familiar with our municipal operations and infrastructure.

Staff negotiated scope and fee with CBBEL. The not-to-exceed fee for these engineering services is \$117,728.51.

Please present this agreement and resolution to the President and Board of Trustees for their review at their regular meeting of September 20, 2007. If approved, please have both signed copies returned to the David Gorman for further processing.
