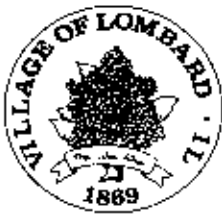

On Tuesday, May 27, 2008, bids were opened for the Street Lighting Maintenance Contract. Bid specifications were sent to eight (8) vendors, resulting in three (3) bidders responding who met Village specifications. The bid results are as follows:

The contract would be in effect for a two year period from June 1, 2008 to May 31, 2010 with a potential extension for one additional two year period. The scope of work includes patrolling the lighting system on a monthly basis, group re-lamping and light head cleaning. Per contract, the Village only pays for actual work performed on a time and material basis as has been done for the past six years. Also, as past practice dictates, Public Works recommends that for the two year term of the contract the successful low bidder be the exclusive Street Lighting Maintenance Contractor; meaning that they will be the only contractor to perform any repairs to the lighting system.

The Public Works Department is recommending that Meade Electric, Inc. be awarded a contract for Street Lighting Maintenance in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 for the period of June 1, 2008 through May 31, 2010. Although the contract reflects the total amount over a two year period, \$100,000 will be paid from each fiscal year.
