- WHEREAS, Father Milota graduated from St. Alexis Grade School in 1980; Immaculate Conception High School in 1984; and the University of St. Thomas in St. Paul, Minnesota in 1988 with a Bachelor's Degree in Philosophy and Classical Languages; received a Baccalaureate Sacred Theology cum laude from Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome, Italy in 1991; and received a Licentiate in Sacred Theology cum laude from Pontifical Athenaeum of St. Anselm in Rome, Italy in 1993; and
- WHEREAS, Father Thomas Milota served as Parochial Vicar at St. Scholastica in Woodridge, Illinois in 1992; Parochial Vicar at St. Peter and Paul in Naperville, Illinois from 1993-1997; Parochial Vicar at Cathedral of St. Raymond Nonnatus in Joliet, Illinois from 1997-2000; served as Director of Pastoral Formation and Apostolic Works at Pontifical North American College in Vatican City State, Europe from 2000-2003 and also as Dean of Academics from 2002-2003; served as Administrator of Sacred Heart Parish in Lombard from 2003-2006 and also as Pastor from 2006-2007; and
- WHEREAS, since his assignment at Sacred Heart Parish Father Milota has increased school enrollment; started a new evangelical program; has brought in key-note speakers from around the world; created ministry groups of all ages to reach out into the community to serve others and has brought together all aspects of the church; and
- WHEREAS, Father Thomas A. Milota will serve the St. Peter and Paul Parish in Naperville, Illinois beginning June 20, 2007;
