The Lombard Police Department is retiring our honorable K9 Chico. Chico has been an integral part of the Lombard Police Department, however his effectiveness is limited.

While we consider Chico a part of our team, state law considers a dog to be property. As Chico was purchased with official government funds, the Village of Lombard has to formally declare Chico to be surplus property.

It is common practice in the police culture for a K9 to be sold to its handler, in our case Officer Greg Sohr.

I am recommending the sale of Chico for a nominal fee to officially transfer ownership to Officer Sohr.

A waiver of first reading is being requested to facilitate the sale.

ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE
OF MUNICIPAL OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard, it is no longer necessary or useful to or in the best interest for the Village of Lombard to retain the following-described personal property:

- One (1) ten-and-a-half year old German Shepherd police dog named “Chico”

now owned by the Village of Lombard; and

WHEREAS, the Village routinely declares such type of personal property surplus when its useful life as a police dog has come to an end, and the best interests of the Village of Lombard will be served by its sale;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the President and Board of Trustees find the following-described property:

- One (1) ten-and-a-half year old German Shepherd police dog named “Chico”

now owned by the Village of Lombard is no longer necessary or useful to the Village of Lombard and the best interests of the Village will be served by its sale to the dog’s current police officer handler, Officer Gregory Sohr, with whom the dog has stayed while a police dog for the Village.

Section 2: Pursuant to said 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village President and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sell the aforementioned personal property now owned by the Village of Lombard to Officer Gregory Sohr for One and No/100 Dollars (\$1.00), and to execute any and all documents necessary to transfer ownership of the personal property to Officer Gregory Sohr, including, but not limited to, a bill of sale relative to said personal property.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval as provided by law.

BILL OF SALE

The Village of Lombard, 255 East Wilson Avenue, Lombard, Illinois 60148 (the "Seller"), in consideration of ONE AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$1.00), and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by the Seller, does hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over unto Gregory Sohr (the "Buyer") the following-described personal property (the "Personalty"):

- One (1) ten-and-a-half year old German Shepherd police dog named "Chico"; said Buyer having been the handler for "Chico" while "Chico" worked for the Lombard Police Department.

Seller hereby represents and warrants to Buyer that Seller is the absolute owner of the Personalty, that the Personalty is free and clear of all liens, charges and encumbrances, and that Seller has full right, power and authority to sell the Personalty and to provide this Bill of Sale. ***ALL WARRANTIES OF QUALITY, FITNESS AND MERCHANTABILITY ARE HEREBY EXCLUDED AND DISCLAIMED.***
