RE: **Administrative Adjudication of Vehicular Standing,
Parking, Equipment and Vehicle Sticker Regulation Violations**

Per your voicemail of November 7, 2006, enclosed please find the following updated Ordinance, relative to the above-captioned matter, for your review:

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 7 OF
THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO THE
ADMINISTRATIVE ADJUDICATION OF VEHICULAR REGULATION VIOLATIONS**

In regard to the Ordinance, please note the following:

1. As State law has changed to impose a minimum \$250.00 fine for handicapped parking violations, the fine schedule in Section 73.09 has been changed accordingly.
2. The Illinois Municipal League will be introducing legislation next Spring to increase the maximum fine from \$250.00 to \$1,000.00. I will keep you advised of the status of the legislation, and will prepare the necessary amendatory Ordinance if the legislation is enacted into law.
