**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A TEXT AMENDMENT
TO THE LOMBARD SIGN ORDINANCE
TITLE 15, CHAPTER 153, SECTION 153.302(D),
OF THE LOMBARD ZONING CODE**

PC 19-02: Text Amendments to the Sign Ordinance: Nonconforming Signs

WHEREAS, the Village of Lombard maintains a Sign Ordinance which is found in Title 15, Chapter 153 of the Lombard Code; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees deem it reasonable to periodically review said Sign Ordinance and make necessary changes; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing to consider text amendments to the Sign Ordinance has been conducted by the Village of Lombard Plan Commission on February 18, 2019, pursuant to appropriate and legal notice; and,

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has filed its recommendations with the President and Board of Trustees recommending approval of the text amendments described herein; and,

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees approve and adopt the findings and recommendations of the Plan Commission and incorporate such findings and recommendations herein by reference as if they were fully set forth herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 15, Chapter 153, Section 153.302(D) of the Lombard Sign Ordinance shall be amended to read in part as follows:

(D) Relocation. Legal, nonconforming signs shall be allowed to be relocated wholly to any other location on the same lot, provided the new sign location meets the applicable setbacks and clear line of sight provisions. Structural elements are not allowed to be changed, as the life of the sign cannot be extended.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
